Designer Shani Risinger Core of **Shani Core Interiors** worked with a dear friend to create her happy, personalized home in North Palm Beach, filled with family heirlooms, art, and color.

"No pattern was too bold and no out-of-the-box idea was dismissed, which made the experience not only fun, but gave us an end result of a totally unique home that reflects her exuberant lifestyle and personality," says Core.

This living space originally featured cream walls and five differ-

ent shades of brown wood across the French doors, beams, mantle, bookcases, and trims. Core's top priority was to unify the color palette and give the space a fresh beginning. She drenched the room from top to bottom in her client's favorite colors of pale aqua and green, which set the tone for the remaining furnishings and accessories.

For the antique sofa, which had been reupholstered at least a half dozen times in the last 50 years, Core found a cheer-

ful Pierre Frey stripe fabric. She then filled the newly painted green bookshelves with her client's various collections, added Billy Baldwin slipper chairs in the same Brunswick & Fils pattern from the adjacent dining room, and surrounded a framed Pucci scarf with a collection of antique oyster plates from Paula Roemer.
